Sakarya University, Business School- Department of Management Information Systems, as one of the five departments of the Faculty of Business, provides Bachelor's, Master's Degrees with thesis, Master's without thesis and Doctorate education. Since the 2013-2014 academic year, our department has been providing graduate education and since the 2016-2017 academic year, our department has been providing doctoral education. The faculty members of our department are academicians who specialize in the managerial, technical, strategic and organizational elements of Management Information Systems and actively conduct applied and theoretical research on Management Information Systems.

Management Information Systems is an interdisciplinary field of study that includes informatics, management and computer concepts. Information Systems has entered every stage of our lives and has radically changed our lives. Decision support systems basic data for managers' decisions and started to be used in intensive businesses as basic systems that provide information. Being able to establish effective communication and interaction between non-technical personnel and technical personnel in the enterprise has been critical for the success of organizations. All these developments have greatly increased the demand in the private sector and the public sector for management information systems graduates.

The experiences students have gained within the scope of the 7 + 1 professional practices course in the 8th semester make them experienced management information systems experts before they graduate.

Students who have completed the program can be employed in the relevant department of their institutions such as at the Ministry of Justice, the Ministry of Family and Social Policies, the Ministry of Science, Industry and Technology, the Ministry of Transport, Maritime Affairs and Communications, such as state universities. Students can work in businesses operating in many different sectors, from banking to food, from insurance to construction. Also, they can apply for master's and doctoral degrees in the field of Management Information Systems or other branches of science that accept students from this field.

All of our 2019 graduates have at least 4 months full-time industry experience. Eighteen (50%) of our graduates are employed. Six (33%) of our 2018 year graduates, who have a job, started to work in the workplace where they did professional practice (16 weeks internship) and 12 (67%) have started work in different workplaces. The top student of our department in 2019 took the first step into being an academic as a research assistant and continues to our department as a Master's student.

Our department has Erasmus agreements with universities from more than 10 countries, In addition, within the scope of Farabi and Mevlana programs, we have bilateral agreements with many universities.
